#### **MORNING - EXPLORE NOTTINGHAM**

Visit an 800-year-old jail and courtroom at The National Justice Museum, take in modern art at Nottingham Contemporary, enjoy a light brunch in one of the quirky coffee shops, or browse boutique stores and unique independent shops.

Pose for a photo by the city's iconic Robin Hood statue, beneath the walls of Nottingham Castle. Here you'll also find England's oldest inn, Ye Olde Trip to Jerusalem.
